The State of Nebraska Office of the CIO is writing to provide you with an update regarding the FY24 Volunteer Fire Department (VFD) Radio Grant.

Motorola Equipment Delivery Expected

SRS is beginning to receive Motorola equipment. Based on estimates, we expect to have enough equipment for the sessions in Gering, Bridgeport, and Hershey, Nebraska, on April 15th, 16th, and 17th respectively. If you were previously registered for one of those three sessions, you should be able to receive your equipment there.

VFDs that are not registered for the sessions listed above will need to register for a different date as new training sessions become available. The SRS plans on rescheduling all canceled sessions as soon as we receive equipment. Currently, June training will become available for registration in early May.

Those who ordered cases will receive them during the training sessions.

VFDs that requested installations will be contacted by their chosen vendors at a later date. The vendor will schedule a time to install the radio in the chosen vehicle. You do not need to bring your VFD's vehicle for training.

Future Grant Opportunities

LB1275 has been incorporated into LB1412, the main budget bill for this year. The bill allocates \$2,000,000 for continuing the VFD SRS Radio Project. Please contact your representative in the state legislature if you would like to see the funding passed.

Grant Conditions

The following is a reminder of the conditions of the FY24 VFD Radio Grant.

- The VFD is expected to perform monthly testing from the department and dispatch center. Monthly testing involves powering on the SRS Radio Kit and speaking with the local PSAP.
- Radios are to remain the property of the State.
- VFDs are expected to maintain inventory tags on the radios.
- Grantees will be required to sign a document and show identification to receive their equipment.
