To all Nebraska Volunteer Fire Departments,

The State of Nebraska Office of the CIO is writing to provide you with an update regarding the FY24 Volunteer Fire Department (VFD) Radio Grant. It has been a busy couple of months, so we thought you would like to know about some of the work the project has completed and what the coming months will entail.

So far, the lottery to select grant awardees has been completed. The winners have been notified, and information has been gathered to ensure they receive their preferred equipment. After we compiled that information, we ordered equipment and began preparing for training and distribution.

The first three "train the trainer" sessions, which provide insight into using the radios and prepare VFDs to train their volunteers, have been scheduled. More training sessions will be available in the coming months. If your department has been awarded equipment, you can register to attend a session <u>here</u>. Sessions in May and June will be open to all departments whether or not they were awarded equipment.

Radio equipment will be delivered during these training sessions, with Kenwood equipment deliveries beginning in Quarter 1 2024 and Motorola equipment deliveries expected by early Q2 2024.

As we move forward, the OCIO expects to have all Kenwood equipment tagged and delivered by April 1st, 2024. Motorola equipment will arrive in February, and training sessions for that equipment will be planned once it is received. By May 6th, the State Radio System plans to have all Motorola equipment tagged and delivered to installation vendors. Delivery currently depends on the manufacturer.

LB1275 has been introduced and is intended to provide additional funding for the grant. Please let your representative in the state legislature know if you would like to see the funding passed.

Grant Conditions

The following is a reminder of the conditions of the FY24 VFD Radio Grant.

- The VFD is expected to perform monthly testing from the department and dispatch center. Monthly testing involves powering on the SRS Radio Kit and speaking with the local PSAP.
- Radios are to remain the property of the State.
- VFDs are expected to maintain inventory tags on the radios.
- Grantees will be required to sign a document and show identification to receive their equipment.

Thank you for your patience as we continue to receive, prepare, and distribute equipment. We look forward to providing your requested SRS-capable radios soon.
