SEPT. 25, 2018 (LINCOLN, NEB.) — Thursday, Sept. 27, the State will co-host their thirteenth annual Nebraska Cyber Security Conference taking place at Southeast Community College's Lincoln Campus. This year's event takes place from 8 a.m. to 4 p.m. at 8800 "O" Street. The conference is for security administrators and IT professionals, including network administrators, system administrators and information security professionals. Over 300 guests have registered to attend.

Keynote speaker Ron Woerner has more than 25 years of IT experience in the security industry. "The Nebraska Cyber Security Conference brings together the top minds from the state in a forum where we can learn from each other to solve our cyber security challenges," Woerner said. "It takes organizational leadership who are willing to invest in people, process and technology. It also requires each person take responsibility for securing their little corner of the internet."
